HAKU UTSAV : GENERAL RULES

- ❖ All the competitions in "Haku Utsav" comprise of individual as well as team events.
- ❖ All the competitions are open to all the students of **Grade 3 to 5** in which they team-up as well as compete with each other irrespective of their Grade.
- ❖ In case of team events, teams are to be formed by students themselves.
- ❖ Once an individual/team has registered, no member will be allowed to change their participation.
- ❖ The events have been divided into five groups as under :
 - 1. Performing Arts 2. Fine Arts 3. Literary
 - 4. Academic 4. Haku Khela
- ❖ A student can participate in the following maximum number of events :
 - 1. Performing Arts, Fine Arts, Literary & Academic Events : Max. 3
 - 2. Haku Khela : Max. 1
- ❖ For events requiring music, such as dance, drama, music competitions, students should upload their music files on the School Website as per the given schedule.
- ❖ No practice/preparation/rehearsal during the school hours will be allowed in the school premises for the competitions.
- ❖ Any obscene/vulgar content will NOT be allowed in any competition.
- ❖ In case of excess registration there will be an elimination round before Hakuna Matata.
- ❖ The decision of the judges will be final and cannot be challenged.

Awards of Excellence

MAST KALANDAR AWARD : To be awarded to three students - one each from Grade 3, 4 & 5 who bag the maximum number of prizes.

- ❖ The winners of Haku Utsav and Haku Khela are eligible to compete for this award.
- ❖ Evaluation of the awards will be based on the number of Gold, Silver and Bronze medals won by the students. A Gold medal carries 15 points whereas the Silver and the Bronze carry 10 and 5 points respectively.

HAKU AUR HUM : FAMILY COMPETITIONS

Important Information

- ❖ **Family Competitions** are open to the families of all the students studying in **Kindergarten to Grade 5**.
- ❖ Only immediate family members i.e. parents, grandparents, and siblings are eligible to participate in the family events.
- ❖ Students' participation is a **must** in all these events.
- ❖ Teams can participate in as many events as they wish.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- ❖ Students have to register for all the Hakuna Matata events - Performing Arts, Fine Arts, Literary, Academic, Sports and Family events - only ONLINE.
- ❖ Registrations will start on 24 January and close on 30 January.
- ❖ **No Registrations will be accepted after 30 January.**
- ❖ For Registration, students and parents are supposed to scan the QR code provided on the Pustak cover page or visit our school website **wisdom.edu.in**
- ❖ For team events in Haku Utsav and Haku Khela, only the Team Leader needs to register on behalf of the entire team.
- ❖ For events requiring music, such as dance, drama, music competitions, students should upload their music files on the School Website as per the given schedule.
- ❖ For Online Events, students should upload their entries on the School Website as per the given schedule.
- ❖ Once an individual/team has registered, no member will be allowed to change their participation.

HAKU UTSAV COMPETITIONS

Dance

1. Naacho Be-Fikr

- This is a duet dance competition.
- Teams can be formed with students of any Grade from 3 to 5.
- Teams can choose any one of the given themes :
 - Indian Folk – Colours of India (one folk style only)
 - Retro Duet – A Fusion of Bollywood and Western Retro
 - Regional Mash up – A Fusion of Regional Blockbusters (Non-Hindi ; Non-Punjabi)
- Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes ; Maximum 3 minutes
- Costumes are a MUST and props may be used.
- The teams will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

2. Groovy Fankaar

- This is a solo dance competition.
- Participants can choose any one of the given themes :
 - Bal Leela – Mythology in Motion
 - Disco Fusion – A Fusion of Bollywood and Western
 - Celebrating Classical Dances of India
- Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes ; Maximum 3 minutes
- Costumes are a MUST and props may be used.
- Participants will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.



3. Nritya Utsav

- This is a group dance competition.
- Teams should consist of minimum 4 ; maximum 6 members.
- Teams can be formed with students of any Grade from 3 to 5.
- Teams can choose any one of the given themes :
 - A Tribute to India
 - A Mythological Dance Ensemble
 - Celebrating Seasons
- Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes; Maximum 3 minutes
- Costumes are a MUST and props may be used.
- The teams will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

Music

4. Music Bandits

- This is a duet singing competition.
- Teams can be formed with students of any Grade from 3 to 5.
- This is an open theme event.
- Language no bar
- Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes ; Maximum 3 minutes
- Teams may use karaoke.
- Use of costumes is a MUST.
- Teams can bring maximum two accompanists. The instruments required for the competition will have to be arranged by the participants themselves.
- The teams will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

5. Beat Battle

- This is a solo instrument playing competition.
- Participants should bring their own instrument.

c. Participants can choose any one of the given themes :

- A Tribute to A.R. Rahman
- Retro Sound - 1950 to 1970 era
- Spiritual Discovery through Bhajans

d. Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes ; Maximum 3 minutes

e. Use of costumes is a MUST.

6. The Sonic Star

a. This is a solo singing competition.

b. Participants can choose any one of the given themes :

- Folk & Feel - Indian Folk
- Global Grooves - Western Songs
- Desi Beats - Bollywood Celebrating Festivals

c. Language no bar

d. Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes ; Maximum 3 minutes

e. Participant may use karaoke.

f. Use of costumes is a MUST.

g. Separate prizes will be announced for 'Indian' and 'Western' categories.

h. Teams can bring maximum two accompanists. The instruments required for the competition will have to be arranged by the participants themselves.

i. Participants will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

Drama

7. Break a Leg

a. This is a solo acting competition.

b. Participants should perform a short dramatic scene or monologue based on any one given situation :

- A child's behaviour at home after Parent-Teacher Meeting
- An honest confession to your best friend






- You have had enough of 'Healthy diet'
- c. The performance should showcase variation in emotions and expressions.
- d. Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes; Maximum 5 minutes
- e. Language no bar
- f. Any display of obscenity, violence, prejudice, defamation etc. is strictly prohibited.
- g. Costumes and props are a MUST.
- h. Participants will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

8. Just Drama

- a. This is a team drama competition.
- b. Teams can be formed with students of any Grade from 3 to 5.
- c. Each team should consist of min. 3 and max. 6 members.
- d. Teams must prepare a short skit based on any one theme given below :
 - A day when everything goes wrong
 - If children ruled the world
 - A day without Internet
- e. Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes; Maximum 6 minutes
- f. Language no bar
- g. Any display of obscenity, violence, prejudice, defamation etc. is strictly prohibited.
- h. Costumes and props are a MUST.
- i. The teams will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

9. Do ka Dum

- a. This is a duet drama competition.
- b. Teams can be formed with students of any Grade from 3 to 5.

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- c. This is an open theme competition where teams should perform a scene without making any eye contact during the performance.
 - d. Time limit: Minimum 2 minutes ; Maximum 5 minutes
 - e. Language no bar
 - f. Any display of obscenity, violence, prejudice, defamation etc. is strictly prohibited.
 - g. Costumes and props are a MUST.
 - h. Students should upload their music files on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.


Fine Arts

10. Create the Thought

- a. This is a solo, concept-based art competition.
- b. Participants must visually represent ANY ONE of the themes given below :
 - Hope • Freedom • Togetherness • Change
- c. The theme must be expressed without writing any words.
- d. Time limit: 1 hour
- e. Participants can use any medium - Drawing, Painting, Collage.
- f. Participants must bring their own material. However, school will provide A3 size ivory sheet and a base.
- g. Any visual references will not be allowed.

11. The Art Relay

- a. This is a team art competition.
- b. Each team should consist of 3 members.
- c. Teams must create one single artwork based on ANY ONE of the themes given below:
 - My Team • From Chaos to Calm • Growing Together
- d. Each participant will get 30 minutes to work on the artwork.
- e. Team members are not allowed to discuss their plan while working.

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- f. Time limit: 90 minutes (in total)
 - g. Participants must bring their own material. However, school will provide with A3 size ivory sheet and a base.
 - h. Any visual references will not be allowed.

12. GUM Laga ke Haisha

- a. This is a team-based craft competition.
- b. Each team should consist of 3 members.
- c. Teams are required to create any 4 craft items from the given list.
 - Pen Stand
 - Photo Frame
 - Paper Toy / Puppet
 - Paper Flower / Flower Bunch
 - Mini Desk Decor (any theme)
 - Wall Hanging
 - Mask (Animal/Character)
 - Greeting Card
 - Decorative Box / Pouch
- d. Time limit: 60 minutes
- e. Teams must bring all the required material.
- f. Any visual references will not be allowed.

Literary

13. Pass the Pen

- a. This is a team-based creative writing competition.
- b. Each team should consist of 2 members.
- c. Teams will be given a set of writing prompts by the organisers.
- d. Participant 1 will begin the piece of writing based on the prompt.
- e. After 20 minutes, the work will be passed to Participant 2, who will continue and complete the writing.
- f. Participants are not allowed to discuss the content with each other during the process.
- g. Time limit :
 - Participant 1 - 20 minutes
 - Participant 2 - 30 minutes
- h. Language : English or Hindi



14. Haku Open Mic

- This is a solo, theme-based spoken word competition.
- Participants must speak about any one of the following :
 - My Favourite Attire
 - My Friend & I
 - What Elders should Not Do
- The piece may be funny, emotional, poetic or dramatic but it must be original.
- Time limit : minimum 2 minutes ; maximum 4 minutes
- Language no bar

15. Thali ka Baingan

- This is a solo spoken expression competition.
- Participants can choose any one from the given topics :
 - Are Books more magical than Movies?
 - Students should have a say in designing school lunch menus.
 - Is it more important to be Kind or to be Honest?
- Participants must begin by speaking FOR the given topic.
- After 2 minutes, the participant will be asked to switch their stance and speak AGAINST the same topic.
- Time limit:
 - For the topic - 90 seconds
 - Against the topic - 90 seconds
- Language no bar

Academics

16. Echoes from the Hidden Land

- This is a team event in which teams are required to create and present a PowerPoint presentation on the given theme.
- Theme : Any one mysterious place on Earth (For example: Magnetic Hill, Jatinga)
 - The presentation should mention the location, the mystery of the place and its scientific or historical explanation, if available.



- The content must be original and factual.
- c. Each team should consist of min. 2 and max. 4 members.
- d. Teams can be formed with students of any Grade from 3 to 5.
- e. Time limit : minimum 2 minutes ; maximum 4 minutes
- f. Language no bar

17. Number Ninjas

- a. This is a solo, mathematics and reasoning-based competition.
- b. This is a pen and paper test.
- c. The competition will include questions from the following domains :
 - Number Patterns
 - Mental Maths
 - Puzzles and Word Problems
- d. Time limit: 45 minutes

18. Hidden Path Challenge

- a. It is a Tech-Based Treasure Hunt challenge.
- b. It is a team event consisting of two members.
- c. Teams can be formed with students of any Grade from 3 to 5.
- d. The team has to showcase logical thinking and decision-making skills through a series of clue-based tasks inspired by programming concepts.
- e. The Treasure Hunt Challenge will include fun and engaging activities such as:
 - Understanding flow charts
 - Making correct decisions
 - Solving puzzles and case studies
- f. Time limit : 30 minutes

19. Rube Goldberg Machine Challenge

- a. Rube Goldberg machine is a device that uses a series of connected steps to complete a very simple task (for eg : pressing a button, balloons popping, marbles rolling, etc), in a fun and

imaginative way. Instead of doing the task directly, the machine does it through a long chain of actions. For example, a falling book might hit a ball, which rolls into a lever, which tips over a glass, which finally presses a button.

- b. In this event, the teams should design and build a Rube Goldberg Machine to accomplish one of following tasks :
- Pouring a glass of water or cereal
 - Turning off alarm clock
 - Putting a ball in glass
 - Light up Christmas tree
 - Release Helium balloon
 - Put out a candle flame
- c. Teams should consist of 2 members only.
- d. Time limit : 2 hours
- e. Chain of Actions : minimum 4 steps ; maximum 6 steps
- f. Team should bring their own material.

Haku Khela

20. Kho-Kho

- a. Each team will consist of 7 players.
- b. Girls and boys will compete in separate groups.
- c. Grade 3, 4 and 5 will compete separately.
- d. The game will have two innings, each lasting 7 minutes.

21. Tug-of-War

- a. Each team will consist of 7 members.
- b. Teams should be mix of both boys and girls.
- c. Grade 3, 4 and 5 will compete separately.

22. Dribbling

- a. This is a solo competition for Grade 5 students only.
- b. Girls and boys will compete separately on a 50 meters track.
- c. Participants have to follow the following rules :
 - Participants must use only one hand while dribbling the ball.
 - Participants may change hands while dribbling.



- Using both hands together while dribbling is NOT allowed.
- Participants must keep dribbling continuously until they cross the finishing line.
- Holding, resting or stopping the ball during dribbling is NOT allowed.
- Rolling the ball on the ground is NOT allowed.
- Dribbling the ball over the shoulder is NOT allowed.

HAKU AUR HUM

(Family Competitions)

Important note : *All the competitions in this category must have student as a participant. A family for participation involves only the Mother, the Father, the Siblings and the Grand Parents.*

1. Light up the Stage

- a. This is a family dance competition.
- b. A team can consist of minimum 2 and maximum of 4 members.
- c. Style of dance and music can be of any genre.
- d. Time limit : minimum 2 and maximum 3 minutes
- e. Any obscene or inappropriate content will NOT be allowed.
- f. Participants will have to upload their music file on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

2. Haku Baithak

- a. It is a family 'Antakshari' entertainer.
- b. Each team must consist of 2 members only.
- c. Teams will compete in a traditional Antakshari format, with fun modern twists.

3. Family Circuit

- a. This is a team event where participants will be required to complete a series of tasks within given time.
- b. Each team must include minimum 2 and maximum 3 members - one student + at least one family member.



4. Haku Family No. 1

- a. This is an exciting competition to identify The Most Compatible Family.
- b. Each team should consist of 2 members.
- c. In this event, there will be a series of rounds designed to test how well the family members know each other.

5. Craft-O-Mania

- a. This is a team-based craft competition.
- b. Each team should consist of 2 members.
- c. Teams are required to create any three out of the six STEAM Craft items using popsicle sticks from the given list within the stipulated time.
 - Windmill
 - Popsicle Stick Catapult
 - Ferris Wheel
 - Popsicle Stick Car
 - Elastic Band Paddle Boat from Ice-cream sticks
 - Robotic Arm
- d. Time limit: 60 minutes
- e. Teams must bring all the required material.
- f. Any visual references will not be allowed.

6. Air Crash

- a. This is a team event
- b. A team should consist of 2 members - 1 student + 1 family member.
- c. In this event, teams will be given a 'Celebrity Jodi' to play.
- d. On the day of the event, participants should dress up and become the 'Celebrity Jodi' and convince the panel of judges, as to why they deserve the only two parachutes available.
- e. Language no bar
- f. Time limit : minimum 2 minutes and maximum 3 minutes
- g. There will be a Q/A session with the panel as well.
- h. Costumes are a MUST.



7. Hum Aapke Hain Kaun

- a. This is a team based drama competition.
- b. A team can consist of minimum 2 and maximum of 5 members.
- c. The team should perform a 'Comedy of Errors' in one of the following scenes :
 - A Big, Fat Indian Wedding
 - A Movie Set
 - A Dramatic Court Scene
- d. Time limit : minimum 2 minutes ; maximum 4 minutes
- e. Costumes and Props are a MUST.
- f. Language no bar
- g. Participants will have to upload their music file, if required, on the School Website between 5 to 7 February 2026.

8. Petal Parade

- a. This is a family competition of fresh flower arrangement.
- b. A team should consist of 2 members (1 parent and 1 student).
- c. Teams should bring their own fresh flowers/vase/containers and other stationery & decoration items as per requirement.
- d. Maximum size of the vase/container base : 8 inches
- e. Maximum number of flower sticks to be used : 8
- f. Time limit : 1 hour 30 minutes
- g. Any visual references will not be allowed.

9. The Click

- a. This is an Online Photography team based competition.
- b. The team should consist of Minimum 2 ; Maximum 5 members.
- c. In this event, the student should capture a funny upside down photograph of the other members dressed and posed as scary monsters. For example Vecna from Stranger Things, members of the Adam's family etc.
- d. Props and costumes are a must.
- e. Participants will have to upload their picture on the School Website between 7 to 9 February 2026.

10. Reel Making competition

- a. This is an Online reel-making competition.
- b. Participants must shoot and edit a 30 to 45 seconds reel based on one of the following themes :
 - Spirit of Hakuna Matata
 - The हालात & the हालत of the parents during Hakuna Matata
 - Me reading Haku Pustak for the first time
- c. Language no bar
- d. The reel should have a definite ending as per the given time limit.
- e. Any display of obscenity, violence, prejudice, defamation etc. is strictly prohibited.
- f. Participants will have to upload their films on the School Website between 7 to 9 February 2026.

11. Ad Banao

- a. This is an Online team based family competition.
- b. The team should consist of minimum 2 and maximum 5 members.
- c. Teams should shoot and create a funny advertisement on any product of their choice.
- d. Teams would be required to formulate a catch line for the proposed product.
- e. Different forms of expression like short skits, jingles, slogans or any other innovative form can be incorporated.
- f. The advertisement may be in any language.
- g. Time limit : minimum 40 seconds; maximum 1 minute
- h. Caution should be taken to refrain from displaying obscenity, violence, prejudice, defamation etc. in advertisements
- i. Costumes and props are a MUST.
- j. Participants will have to upload their films on the School Website between 7 to 9 February 2026.



12. Filmy Chakkar

- This is an Online drama based family team competition.
- The team should consist of minimum 2 ; maximum 6 members.
- Teams should recreate any movie scene from 1970-2000 era.
- Scene can be picked from any movie from any film industry.
- Time limit : minimum 2 minutes ; maximum 4 minutes
- Language no bar
- Costumes and props are a MUST.
- Participants will have to upload their films on the School Website between 7 to 9 February 2026.

BEEJI - BAAUJI KODAK MOMENT **A Walk of Love Across Generations**

- Beeji-Baauji is a special participation event exclusively for Kindergarten students.
- The event celebrates the bond between STUDENTS and their GRANDPARENTS.
- Students and their grandparents will take a collective walk through the audience up to the main stage, creating a moment of togetherness. This walk is designed to be a special Kodak moment, capturing the warmth and joy of shared memories.
- The event will conclude with a group photograph on stage.
- Beeji-Baauji will mark the finale of Day One of Hakuna Matata.
- Registration will be done through the same QR code registration process as other events.
- Registered grandparents are requested to report to the event in-charge at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled event time.
